Wakefield, Rhode Island—October 14, 2010. The Wakefield Concert Band is pleased to announce that it will perform its Second Annual Free Holiday Concert for the South County Community on Monday, December 6, 2010, at 7:00 pm at South Kingstown High School, Columbia Street, Wakefield, RI.

Admission is free but the band is requesting donations of items such as toothbrushes, deodorant, toilet paper, and soap to benefit the Jonnycake Center in Peace Dale, RI.

“We are often reminded about food issues but people need personal care items and paper goods, as well,” says Jill Lieberman, the band’s music librarian and wife of band Director Barry Lieberman.

After the Second Annual Holiday Concert on December 6, community members are invited to enjoy complimentary homemade refreshments prepared by members of the band.

During this year’s summer concerts at Marina Park, Wakefield, RI, the band raised more than 2500 pounds of food through cash and nonperishable food donations for the Jonnycake Center emergency food pantry.

Since 2008, the Wakefield Concert Band has raised nearly \$15,000 through annual concerts benefitting South County Hospital.

The Wakefield Concert Band, founded in the late 1890’s in South Kingstown, RI, is an all volunteer, community concert band that has been playing music throughout Rhode Island for more than a century. Band members, who come from all walks of life, share one singular goal, says Band Director Barry Lieberman: To encourage community cultural enrichment and musical enjoyment through public performance.
